Dress Code - April 10, 2010

1. Traditional and acceptable options include;
 - a. Dark suit w/tie
 - b. White suit w/tie
 - c. Sunday best slacks w/jacket, dress shirt and tie
 - d. **Not** Appropriate for boys;
 - i. No gym shoes or flip flops please
 - ii. Please do not give your son any items to carry during Mass*. He must be able to walk with his hands reverently folded prepared for prayer.
2. Girls: Traditional and acceptable options include;
 - a. White dress w/veil or simple hair decoration. (Veils are OPTIONAL).
 - b. Sunday best light/pastel color dress
 - c. **Not** Appropriate attire for girls:
 - i. No gloves (the Precious Body may only come in contact with skin. Please leave your gloves at home).
 - ii. No long dresses to the floor or trains (the girls must be able to sit, stand and kneel without interference from their clothing).
 - iii. Avoid capes or other items that do not fit comfortably on your daughter's shoulders. No spaghetti straps.
 - iv. Please do not give your daughter any items to carry during Mass*. She must be able to walk with her hands reverently folded prepared for prayer.
 - v. No low cut or short mini dresses.
 - vi. No backless shoes or heels, flip flops, or tennis shoes please.

***Items to be blessed will be done at the end of Mass. (Bibles, Rosaries etc.)**

We will not be having or lighting any candles this year.
